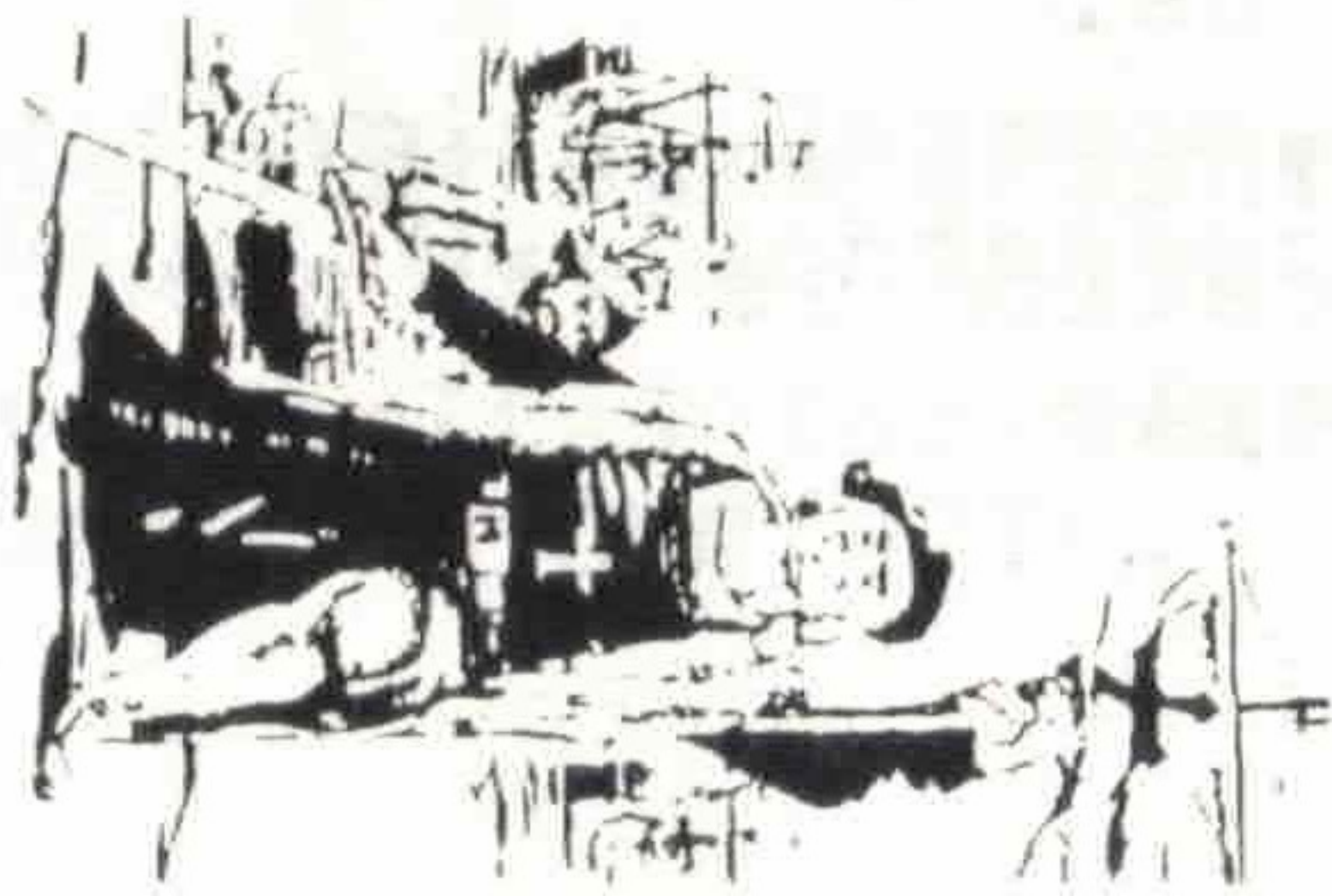

MEMORARE--EVERY MONTH..

On August 15, we commemorate our Blessed Mother's triumphant Assumption into Heaven.

The 15th also marks the end of the Marian Year which our Holy Father initiated on June 7, 1987.

Bishop Thomas V. Daily, Supreme Chaplain of the KofC, says:

"Devotion for the Blessed Virgin...is evident in the Order from the top right down through the grass roots. This is particularly evident in the Knights' devotion to the Rosary." (Columbia, August 1988)

Our Council is no exception. We chose our Blessed Mother, under her title of Our Mother of Confidence, as our patroness and also our namesake.

We are all familiar with Mary's titles, as delineated in her Litany.

But how many people are aware that we venerate her, under various titles, one or more times every month of the year?

For instance, this month we commemorate the feasts of Our Lady of the Snows, on the 5th; Our Lady, Refuge of Sinners, on the 13th; the Assumption, on the 15th; Our Lady of Knock, Ireland, on the 21st; the Immaculate Heart of Mary, on the 22nd; Our Lady of Consolation, on the 28th; and Our Lady, Health of the Sick, on the day before the last Sunday of August.

In subsequent issues of THE CONFIDER, we will list the feasts of our Blessed Mother for that month.

In the meantime, why not a few words about:

MOTHER OF CONFIDENCE...

Under the title, Our Lady of Confidence, the Blessed Virgin has been venerated in many churches in Italy.

But the most notable is the Chapel of the Major Seminary in the Lateran Palace in Rome.

Pope John XXIII, an alumnus of the seminary, often prayed there before the picture of Our Lady of Confidence.

He celebrated his first Mass there and, after he became Pope, he frequently visited the chapel.

Rome was twice saved from the ravages of cholera, after the people placed their confidence--and their fate--in the hands of Our Lady of Confidence.

During World War I, 124 seminarians from the Roman Seminary were called to serve. They were placed under her protection.

All returned safely to the seminary.

In 1941, a Dominican Sister lay dying in Michigan. The Sisters invoked the help of Mary: "My Mother, My Confidence." The Sister recovered.

The Feast Day of Our Mother of Confidence is celebrated on the Second Sunday in Lent.
