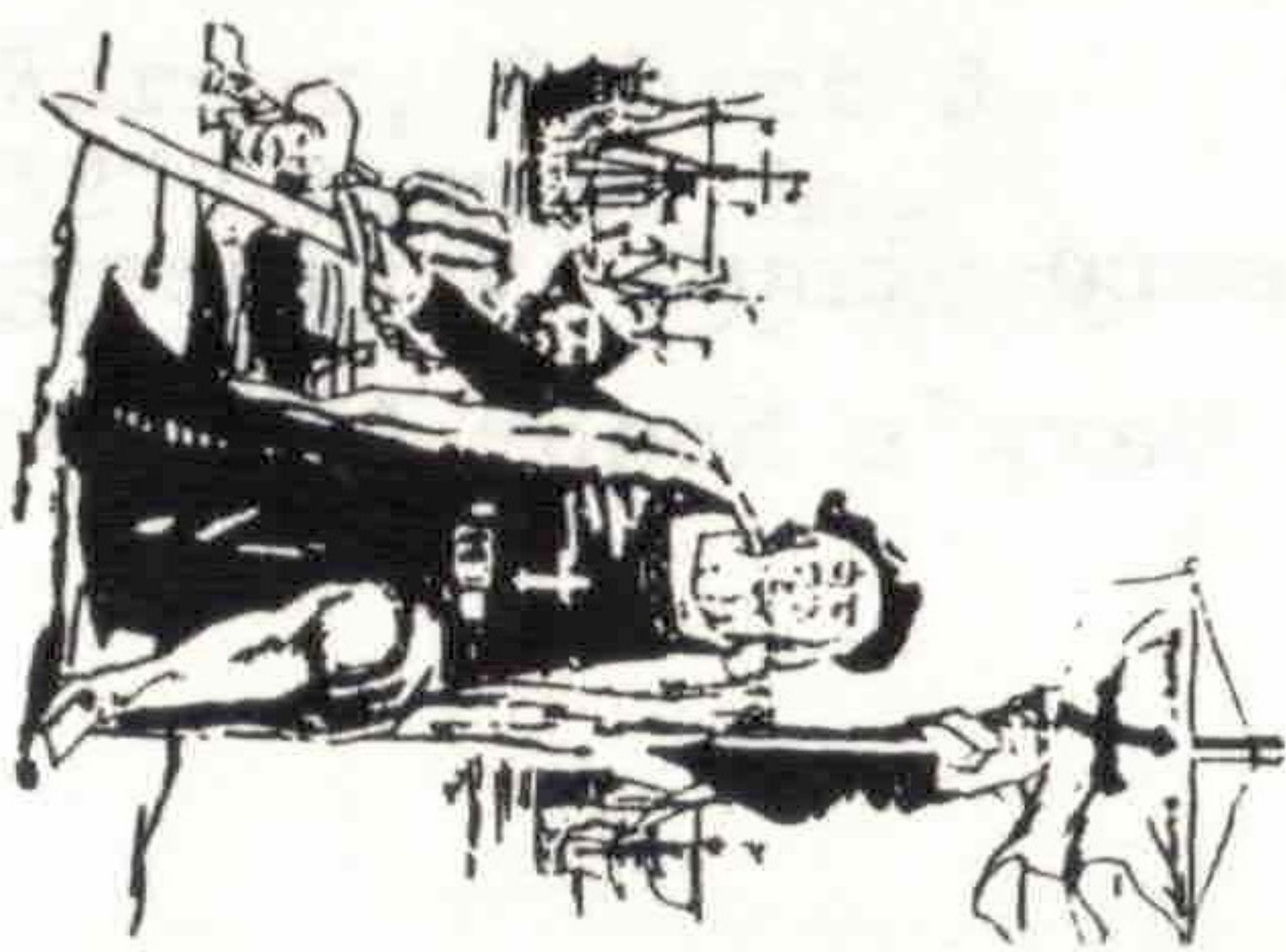

THIS IS MARY'S LAND

On August 15, Pope John Paul II closed his Marian Year in a Vatican ceremony.

Many years ago, Catholic America adopted Mary as its Patroness, under the aegis of her Immaculate Conception. And, under her title, Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mary is called Patroness of the Americas.

Why, then, was there so little public celebration of the 1987-88 Marian Year in Catholic America?

Were we, in the Knights of Columbus, just as remiss? On Page 2 of These Men They Call Knights, we read:

One of his first moves [Supreme Knight Virgil C. Dechant] was to place his stewardship under the patronage and protection of Our Lady, and he formalized this dedication during a pilgrimage to the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC, soon after he took office. As a further concrete sign of his devotion to the Blessed Virgin under her title, "Our Lady of the Rosary," he implemented a plan to present a special "K. of C. Rosary" to each new member enrolled in the society. These have been distributed at the rate of 10,000 per month over the last several years. A subsequent program--"The Pilgrim Virgin-Marian Hour of Prayer"--attracted almost one million participants to almost 5,000 prayer services Orderwide in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas.

An excellent beginning!

But where else have we heard about it since?

And what have we done in Mary's honor lately?
