Investigators said a short exhaust pipe on a generator allowed the lethal gas to enter the area where the four were sleeping.

In February, we commemorate the following feasts of Our Blessed Mother:

2 Purification of the BVM

This is one of the oldest feasts of Our Lady. In conformance with the Law of Moses, Mary went to Jerusalem, 40 days after the birth of Jesus, to offer the prescribed sacrifice of a lamb or two doves. Being poor, Mary and Joseph offered the doves.

11 Apparitions at Lourdes

In 1858, Mary appeared 18 times to 14-year old Bernadette Soubirous. (Her name was actually Marie Bernard, but because of her small stature, she was called Bernadette.)

In these apparitions, Mary proclaimed:

I AM THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION!

TRUSTS AND WILLS

At our Social Meeting on January 18th, Lecturer George Uberti introduced Ed Kuenster, our Founding Grand Knight, now our Insurance Agent.

Ed briefly explained the Knights' Insurance program. Then he introduced Jerry Pitzer, General Agent, responsible for providing the insurance coverage for over 12,000 Knights and their families.

Jerry discussed the programs and benefits provided by K of C insurance. He told us: "We run into families unprepared for life, with no plans for the future. Bob O'Neill and I have been preparing presentations on how to form your own program...The K of C is the only insurance company in the U.S. that has not cut dividends in the past few years. And it is the only insurance company that increased its dividends last year."

Jerry then introduced Robert F. O'Neill, an attorney specializing in trusts, wills, and estate management.

Brother O'Neill presented a slide program: **ESTATE PLANNING SEMINAR**, prepared by Richard M. Kettley, JD, CLU, ChFC. It asked a question we should all think about: "What happens to your estate at death?"

The slides graphically portrayed Death Taxes, Accounting Fees, Appraiser's Fees, Probate Fees, Attorney Fees, and Executor's Commissions.

We were then showed how to manage our estates so that our heirs could avoid probate and realize the maximum benefits which we had planned for them.
