Abortion clinic closed

NEW ORLEANS — The city's best-known abortion clinic has closed after authorities seized its equipment for failing to pay federal fines. The penalties were ordered because clinic doctors illegally prescribed drugs.

The clinic's lawyer contends the seizure was more than a matter of \$337,000 in fines, but a stroke against abortion.

"I've talked to people all over the country, and this is the only time this has ever happened," said Charles Cotton, an attorney for Delta Women's Clinic, after its equipment and furniture were seized Friday.
