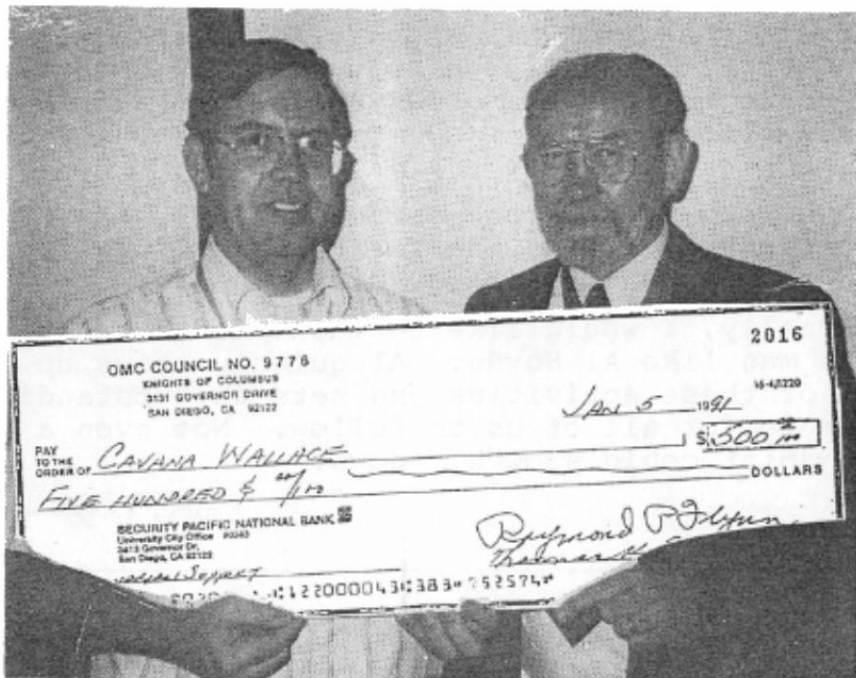

Our Blessed Mother has always been willing to help bring victory to a just cause.

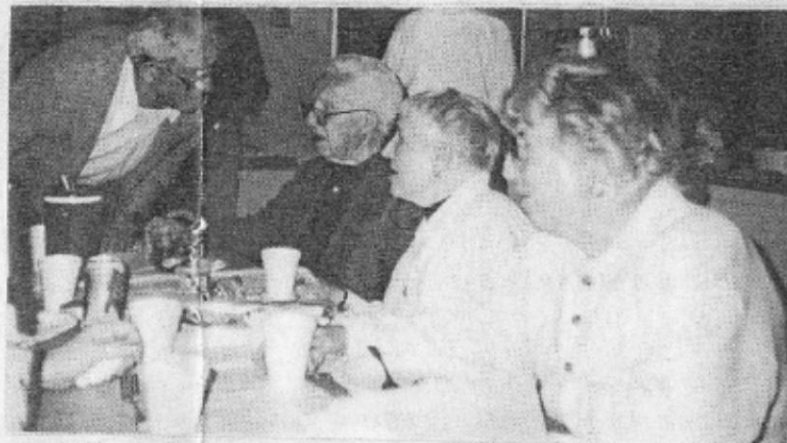
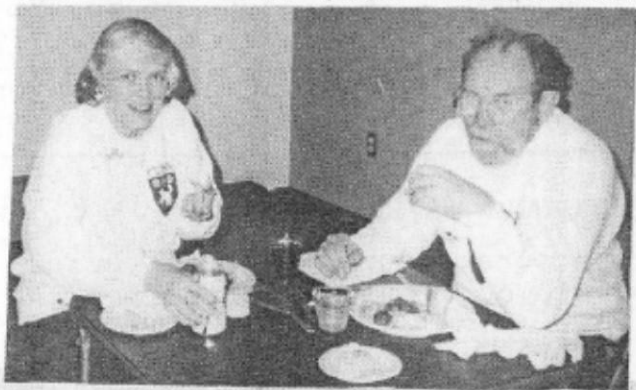
In the 7th Century, the army of Heraclius, Emperor of Constantinople, destroyed the Persian army. The Persians had raided Jerusalem and stolen the True Cross on which Christ died. The confident soldiers of Heraclius marched into battle singing hymns of praise to Mary.

On 7 October 1571, the Christian forces, led by Don Juan of Austria, annihilated the Turks, who were threatening to invade and ravish all of Europe. Before the battle began, Pope (St.) Pius V ordered the Rosary to be recited, to invoke Mary's help.

At the very moment of the miraculous victory, the Holy Father was praying to Mary in his private chapel. In gratitude, he instituted the Feast of the Holy Rosary (October 7) and inserted a new title into her Litany:
