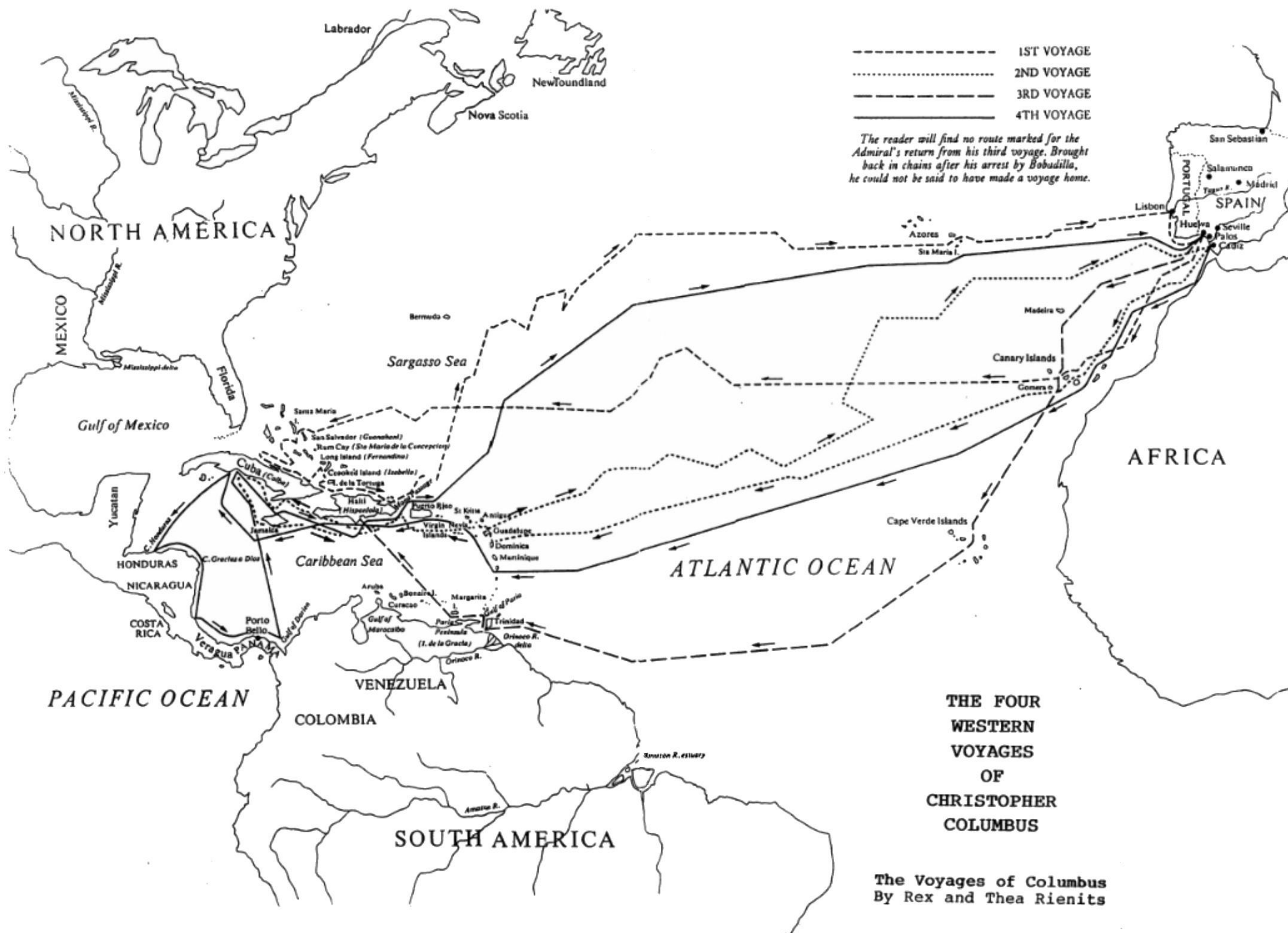

Gonxhe Bojaxhi, now known internationally as Mother Teresa, was born, in 1910, of Albanian parents, in Skopje, which is now the capital of the Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.

By a decree of President Ramiz Alia, Mother Teresa was recently granted Albanian citizenship and a diplomatic passport.

During the past year, Mother Teresa has visited Albania twice to organize help for the poor, the victims of the now defunct communist system.
